

ABOUT THE PROGRESS OF THE EUROPEAN CARBON FOOTPRINT OPTIMISATION PROJECT

This time, we are reporting the fourth and last time on our nearly two years of work. The ECO2 team was not inactive after the second interim report either. In spring we held an online meeting in order to discuss the tasks ahead.

In March, HuMob Group Ltd, the coordinator of the project joined the largest garbage collection action of the country for cleaner Hungary – "Te SZEDD!" Program. Within the framework of the program 50 bags of trash were collected around the head

office of the company in Inárcs and its surroundings. NGOs and high school students from the vocational school of Dabas also joined the cooperation.



On 8-9th April we held our fourth and final transnational meeting.

As the venue of the meeting we selected the originally planned Bacau city. The meeting was organized in Podu cu Ianturi Hotel. As the main content element, among the intellectual outputs, the finished comics to be evaluated were presented. During the meeting we evaluated the internal questionnaire of the previous conferences and the joint work. The end result was very positive. Together, we reviewed our second interim report and the feedback given to it. Our project partner, Grigore Antipa College hosted us, for whom we thank gratefully for their hospitality.

We worked in three main areas in the last two months: ECO videos, ECO guide and the final report.

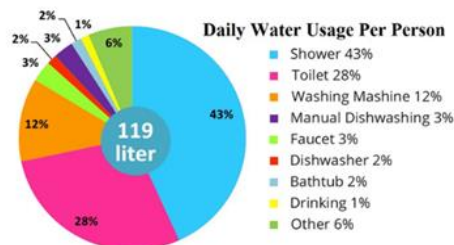


When designing and evaluating intellectual outputs, we strive to take into account all aspects that can be applied in the future after the project has been completed.

Grigore Antipa College and Anamur Vocational and Technical Anatolian High School) at the same time, organize their own multiplication events, which is a mandatory task of the project.



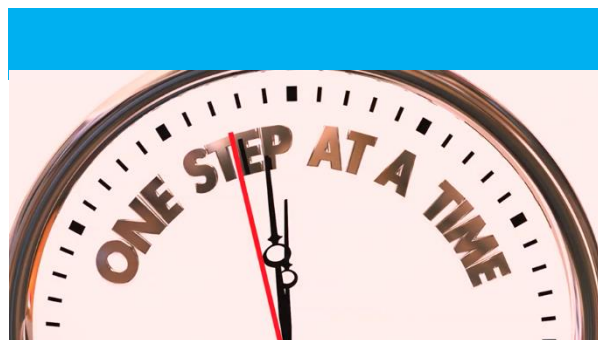


According to the World Health Organization (WHO), approximately 120 liters of water is needed per day so that we can maintain our lives and ensure our basic needs.
